
Newport M.U.D. Community Newsletter

Federal Assistance

If your home sustained damages from the Winter Weather Event and your insurance did not cover them at 100% or you do not have insurance, you may be eligible for federal assistance. The fastest and easiest way to apply is by visiting www.disasterassistance.gov.

If it is not possible for you to register online, you can call <u>1-800-621-3362</u>. The Deadline to apply is April 20, 2021
