The easiest way to conserve thousands of gallons of water around your home is to reduce the water you use on your landscape.

5 WAYS to conserve WATER in the YARD



Use a **broom**, not a **water hose**, to clean driveways and sidewalks.



When your kids want to cool off, use the **sprinkler** where your lawn needs it most.



Use porous material when making walkways and patios to prevent wasteful runoff and keep water in your yard.



A running hose can let out up to **10 gallons of water per minute!** Set your kitchen timer to remind you when to turn off the sprinklers.



Ever heard of **xeriscaping**? This landscaping method uses low-water-use plants to limit your water use. Check out the variety of options there are to adding beautiful plants for less water! Do your research to find beautiful plants with less required upkeep!
